Jennifer has made a complicated and inefficient system, of different application processes, much more approachable to students. She allowed me to customize OSU GO for better access by students and those involved in teaching students about their program abroad. Recommenders also use this system, and these can be internal or external users, but online access is required to enter recommendations via the portal, which Jennifer maintains and customizes.

Jennifer's customers are students, faculty, staff, and external recommenders who support a student's opportunity to go abroad. She has infinite patience with application managers as

the system has a steep learning curve. Jennifer developed a customized 'user guide' for me, arranged multiple occasions for us to meet and review the needs of my college, my position and student/end users. She has taken all of my feedback and worked very skillfully and thoughtfully to tailor this tool to meet my needs, while also allowing for future adaptations.
